**CONTENT: Explore a variety of techniques associated with textiles and develop the skills and ability to translate these to fabric through a textiles-based project.**

During this course, you will be introduced to a range of processes for working with different dye applications and textile paints. You will learn about block printing, screen-printing processes, stencils, resists on fabric, and various types of applique, machine embroidery and basic 3D construction.

While techniques will be taught assuming no prior textiles experience, those wishing to build on their knowledge will have the opportunity to work with the tutor at a more advanced level. These classes are therefore suitable for beginners to experienced artists.
